

Gift Aid Declaration

Gift Aid is a government scheme whereby charities can reclaim basic-rate income tax paid on gifts received.

Please read the notes below before completing the Gift Aid declaration:

- 1 You can cancel this declaration at any time by notifying the Church Office.
- 2 If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and/or capital gains equal to the tax that Cornerstone reclaims, you can cancel your declaration (see note 1).
- 3 If you pay Income Tax at the higher or additional rate and you want to receive the additional tax relief due to you, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self Assessment tax return or ask HMRC to adjust your tax code.
- 4 If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, contact the Church Office, or ask your local tax office for leaflet IR113 Gift Aid.
- 5 If you are married and both pay tax, two separate declarations will need to be made if you wish us to collect tax from both of you.
